# Every Child Ready to Read Skill

## Talk

Children learn most from books when they are actively involved. Prompt your little ones to say something about the book you are reading together. You can:

- Leave a blank at the end of a sentence for the child to fill in. (Ex. “Then the caterpillar turned into a beautiful \_\_\_\_\_.”)
- Ask open-ended questions. (Ex. “What is happening in this picture?”)
