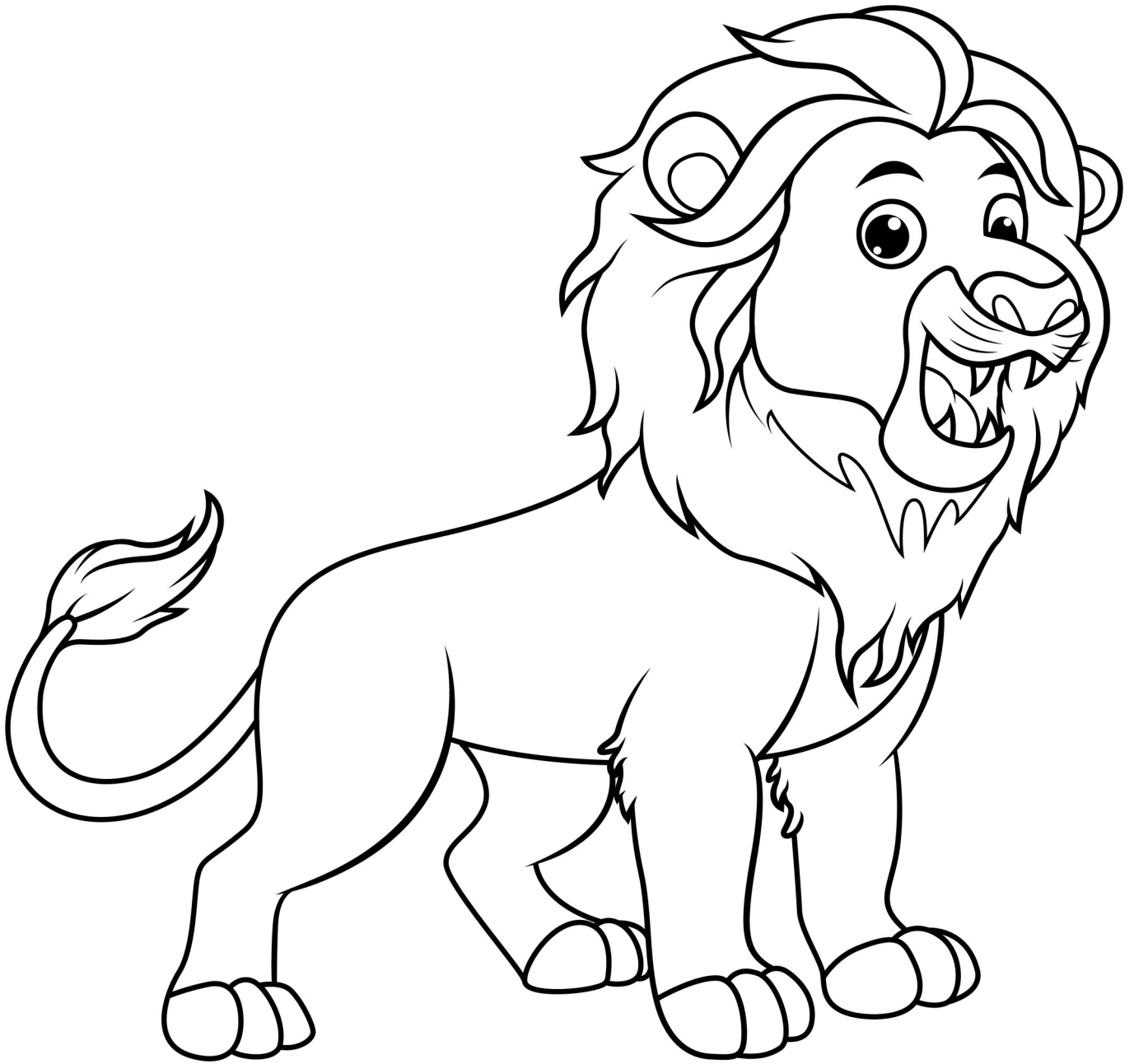


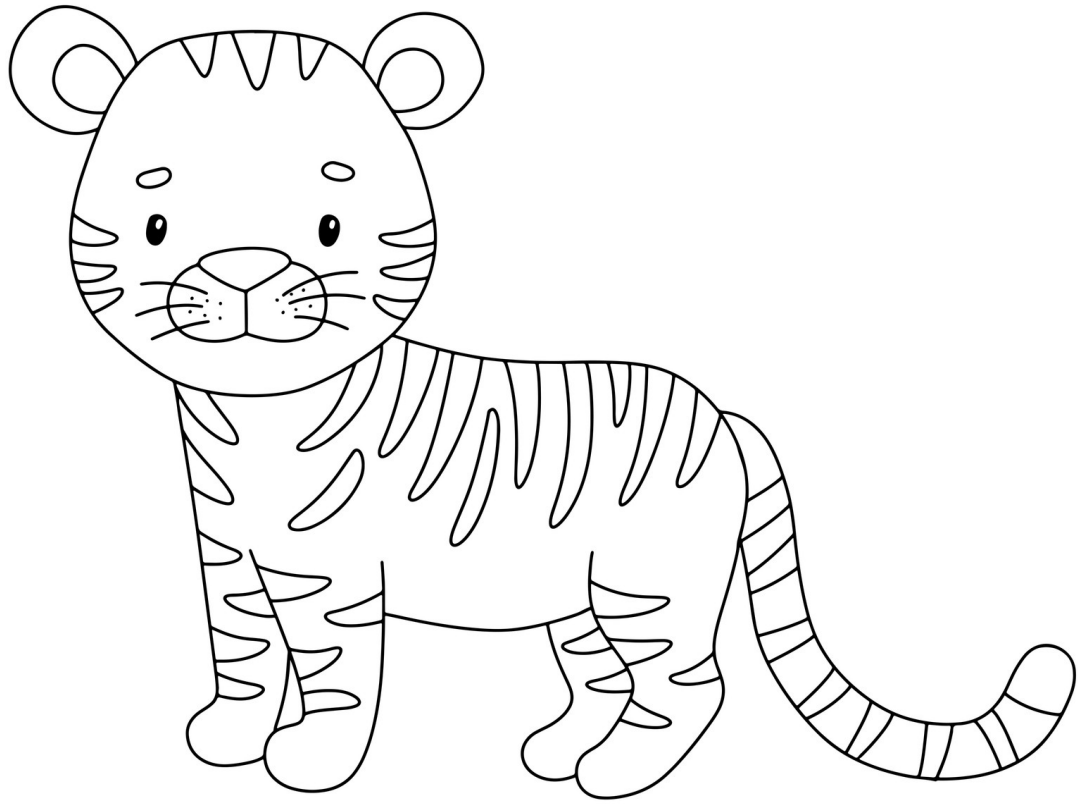

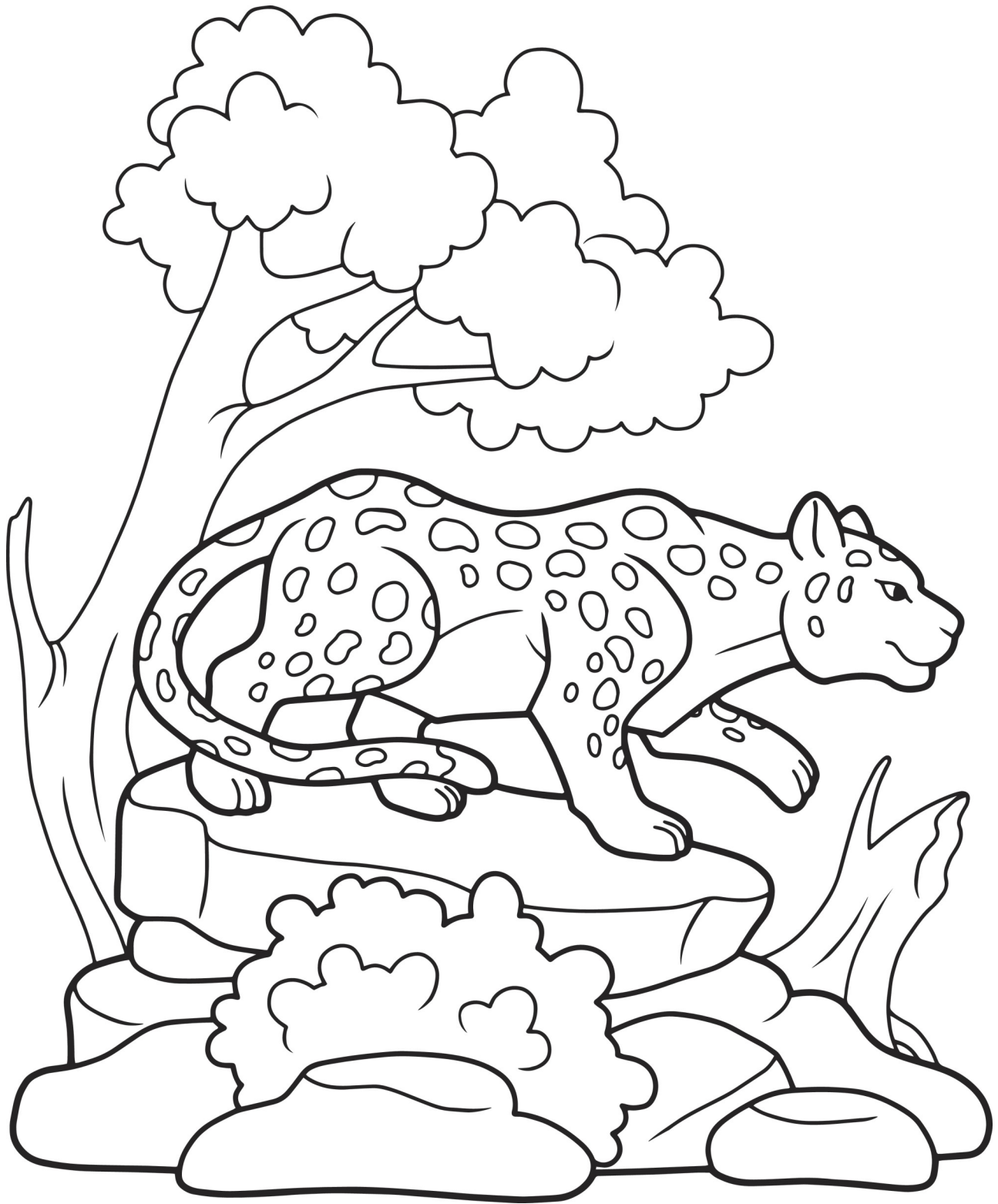

The baby hokey pokey is fun!

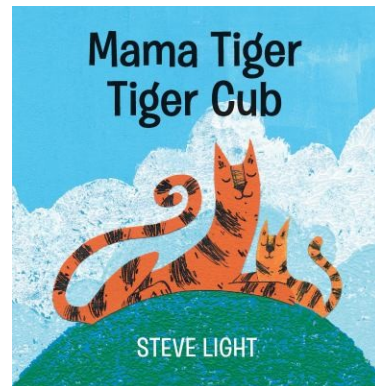

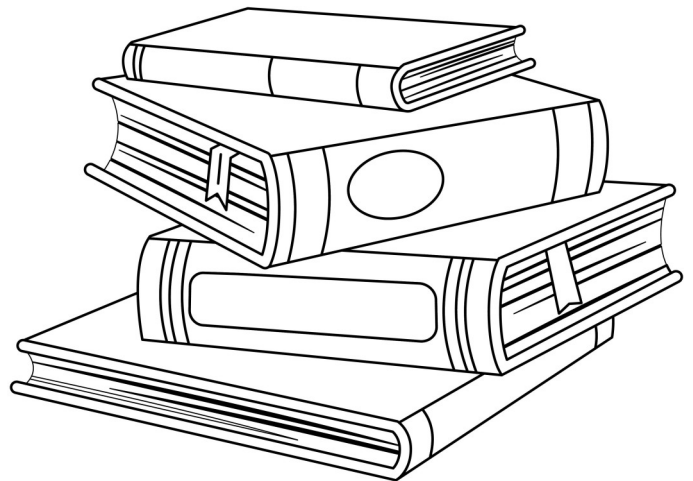
