BUDGET REVIEW

The Library's FY2021 monthly budget reports for August 2021 were reviewed along with monthly activity summaries.

The Library Board was briefed regarding supply chain issues impacting many of the Library's book distributors and project materials ordering as a result of the COVID pandemic.

DIRECTOR'S UPDATE

The Board of County Commissioners voted to reappoint Maggie Mardirosian for another term as District 1 representative on the Public Library Board. New Library Board member, Lauren Guerin, was appointed to represent District 2.

The County is conducting redistricting information sessions. The Library Board was advised that any future changes may affect individual Public Library Board seats. Staff will provide a follow up when the process is complete.

The Hillsborough Literacy Council recently held their annual Tutor/Student Appreciation event. This year's edition of Visions publication was shared featuring poetry composed by students of the literacy and English skills programs.

An update was provided on the Library's solar program, where panels are located, statistics and cost savings via a lower energy bill.

The Board of County Commissioners will hold a budget meeting this evening to officially adopt the FY 2022 budget and set the millage rate. The millage rate will remain the same for the Library.

Jennifer Iley, new branch supervisor for Maureen B. Gauzza Library, was introduced.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:40 pm.
